Description :

made of aluminized para-aramid fabric 500g / m²- Unlined - Velcro closing strap to hold under the sole (this strap is made to easily break in case of hanging to avoid a fall) -

Formable metal bar to bend before the first use to fit the roundness of the top of the foot to prevent the gaiter from turning even in the absence of the strap

Very light gaiters - advised for extended wear - all KEVLAR® wire seams

Recommandation

Protection of ankles and feet against thermal hazards (radiant heat and molten metal splashes) - the aluminized coat must cover about 10cm to create a tile effect and prevent projections from penetrating

Maintenance :

A dirty clothe may cause a reduced protection/

no washing advised, do clean with a damp sponge

Storage : Protected from the light and in a dry place, free of moisture, oils, greases...

Recommandation :

to ensure optimum protection, this equipment must be the complement of appropriate PPEs (shoes, coat, aprons, gloves, head protection) and must be worn consistently. Coat and apron should cover about 10cm the lapings
